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1. Guide and Introduction

1.1. Intended Use

1.3. Introduction/Notes

These operating instructions provide you with all the information you need for the safe and efficient use of your Interior Lighting.

You are required to always comply with the applicable laws and regulations of the country in which you are located. These may differ from the information provided in these operating instructions.





The respective operating and user manuals of the vehicle and vehicle body manufacturers must also be observed and are considered applicable.

- The latest version of the operating instructions is always available from the manufacturer or can be accessed on our website.
- These operating instructions must be read in full before commissioning.
- Keep the operating instructions readily accessible at all times for reference. They should be carried in the vehicle and be accessible to the driver at any time.
- If the vehicle with the Interior Lighting is passed on to third parties, the operating instructions must also be provided.

1.4. Use of the Operating Instructions

- These operating instructions describe all options and features available for this model. Some descriptions may not apply depending on the variant you have selected.
- The table of contents at the beginning of the operating instructions will help you to orientate yourself quickly.
- The directional indications such as left or right or front or rear always refer to the driving direction.

2. Inspection and Maintenance

- Regular inspections, maintenance, and care are important and necessary to ensure the operational and traffic safety, as well as the value retention, of your Interior Lighting.
- When installing or removing the Interior Lighting, always follow the vehicle manufacturer’s instructions.
- The Interior Lighting System must only be installed, serviced, or repaired by qualified personnel. Any country-specific regulations and the vehicle manufacturer’s installation requirements must be observed. Country-specific installation instructions can be obtained from your vehicle body manufacturer or the vehicle manufacturer.
- Care must be taken to ensure that no liquids enter the interior of the vehicle. The Interior Lighting System is not waterproof and must therefore be protected from splashing water.

2.1. Inspection

➤ Carry out regular function tests to ensure the proper operation of the system.



2.2. Maintenance

- **General:** Dirt can impair the function of your Interior Lighting. Therefore, keep it clean and, as far as possible, avoid contamination!
- If necessary, wipe the Lighting with a damp cloth and then dry it with a dry cloth.
- Direct contact with water must be avoided!

Operating the KIA PV5 Retrofit Interior Lighting

3.1. Control elements

Main switch (on the right B-pillar)

The main switch is used to switch the entire Interior Lighting on and off.

„ON“ Position

- Both lights are activated with a dim blue light.
- The blue light serves as night-time and orientation lighting.

„OFF“ Position

- The Interior Lighting is completely switched off.
- The touch controls of the lights are inactive.

Touch control of the lights

Function

- By touching the touch control, the respective light switches from blue night light to normal white light.
- The white light is suitable for illuminating the vehicle interior.

3.2. Operation

Switch on night light

- Set the main switch to „ON“.
- Both lights switch on automatically.
- The lights emit a dim blue light (night light mode)

Activate white interior lighting

- Make sure that the main switch is set to „ON“.
- Touch the touch control in the middle of the desired light.
- The respective light switches to bright white light.



Switch off interior lighting

- Set the main switch to „OFF“
- All lights are switched off

3.3. Notes

Each light can be independently activated and deactivated via its own touch control.
The Lighting may only be operated with a properly installed electrical system.
Do not cover the lights in order to ensure adequate heat dissipation.
The touch controls respond to a light touch. Firm pressure is not required.
When the main switch is **turned off**, the touch functions are **deactivated**.
